This month, we welcome Jayden Lin and his parents, Rhonda & Rick to Skyline Preschool. Welcome!

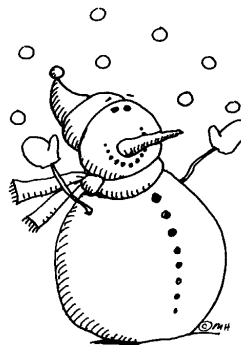


